March 17th, 2022

- Meeting called to order by Brian P at 7:07
- Brian, Anna, Vic B, Chris, Vic C, Rebecca, Carrie and David are in attendance
- Approval of Minutes: Anna approves and Rebecca 2nds, all approved
- · Reports of Officers
 - Treasurer's Report (Rebecca)
 - Rebecca has created a new account #286 for FredNat's 5K
 - There is \$29.24 is left on the Dick's Sporting Goods Card
 - There is \$50 in the cash box
 - Grand Prix deposits for SPCA and Cabin Fever have been received
 - Rebecca has purchased 3 books of stamps
 - Howard and Rebecca will start taxes in the next couple of weeks
 - The checks that were going out were mostly reimbursement checks
 - A reminder if we pay directly from club funds, we are tax free. If someone pays out of pocket there are taxes.
 - Some of the accounts have negative balances because we started buying bibs and timing deposits.
 - 3 more sponsorship checks for the GTR (\$1250) and those checks will be reflected on the budget next month.
