### <u>Treasurer's Report (Rebecca Ivester)</u>

- As agreed on at the last board meeting, Rebecca (RAI) moved the Heppe 15k donation to the club from Account 331 (Donation Income) to Account 311 (Community Outreach).
   The donation amount was \$974.30 and we voted to move the total amount
  - RAI used money from this account to cover the purchase of Malware protection for the website. Brian purchased this for the website for \$99.00
  - For next year, we will modify the "Domain Renewal" account to be a general "Website" account, that will provide funds for the cost of domain renewal, malware protection, and other ad hoc website-related needs
- RAI is closing out the Downtown Mile account tomorrow; owes Sara \$12 reimbursement
- Braswell prize checks are written and will be sent once RAI purchases more envelopes
- We still have only received one quarterly Grand Prix sponsorship from Lucky Road. We received the first one in August and I deposited it on August 20
  - For reference, by October 15 of last year, we had received all four payments from Lucky Road
- RAI is walking the Banquet deposit over to Water's End after this meeting
- The Ospreys still have about \$150 left in their RRCA Grant account. The money is use-it-(by the end of the year)-or-lose-it
- RAI believes she is all caught up on making adjustments to the accounts relating to merchandise–specifically, making sure I am using Account 193 and Account 372
- RAI's outstanding items:
  - Review the taxes
    - Vic Culp did the taxes, RAI just needs to review. Vic read the financial spreadsheets into Quicken. The same setup can be used when we do taxes next year
    - Vic was able to emulate the balance sheets with assets and funds. It is simpler than our current method in part because you only need to do a single entry. Quicken is cheaper and easier than Quickbooks

- Move money race accounts that have been closed out for this year to the Grand
   Prix account to get an updated balance for that account
  - Not Grand Prix related, but the funds that remain in the Great Train Race (GTR) account need to be moved to the Operations account. GTR gives a percent (10%?) of its proceeds each year to the club; that is what this "leftover" money is, RAI just never moved it

## Vice President Report (Vic Barthelemy)

- The Ospreys have been meeting from 6:00 7:15 PM and have, on average 30-40/50 kids. They will continue to meet through the end of October. Going to move 5:30-5:45 PM start time—more likely 5:30 PM than 5:45 PM
- Ospreys have been participating in a lot of races and have about 20-25 per race
- Dana bought shirts for kids and kids/families are able to purchase them through Dana
- Lots of good use of the supplies purchased with the RRCA grant
- Grattan (our Virginia RRCA state rep) had no comments about a single heat at the Downtown Mile for Ospreys
  - o Grattan and the MCM lady (name?) were impressed with number of Ospreys
- Ospreys also had a high turnout at Braswell 5k
- William will continue to post in the newsletter about admin for Ospreys
  - They did have someone volunteer to help out

#### Merchandise (Vic Barhelemy)

- Winter merchandise is out at Lucky Road (LR); summer merchandise remains on the floor, too
- LR gave us a slightly bigger rack
- Plenty of hoodies; good number of windbreakers; quarter-zips are low-ish for men, but we have a fair amount of women's
- Vic B will talk to Steph about long sleeves; we only have the OG (Vic B, this means "original gangsta," which essentially means old-school or original-figured I'd throw in a special note for you since you (and probably Vic C) are the only ones who will read this. Ha!) "silver" right now

#### **Grand Prix (Vic Barthelemy and Brian Pessolano)**
